Scripture Lesson:

First Lesson: Isaiah 6:1-8 (NIV) *The God of our salvation, who has revealed himself to us in his incarnate Son, Jesus Christ, is triune—three divine Persons in one God. This is the God Isaiah saw in his vision. Through faith in Christ, believers stand before God cleansed of sin and holy in his sight.*

¹ In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord seated on a throne, high and exalted, and the train of his robe filled the temple. ² Above him were seraphs, each with six wings: With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and with two they were flying. ³ And they were calling to one another: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory." ⁴ At the sound of their voices the doorposts and thresholds shook and the temple was filled with smoke. ⁵ "Woe to me!" I cried. "I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty." ⁶ Then one of the seraphs flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. ⁷ With it he touched my mouth and said, "See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for." ⁸ Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!"

¹⁴because those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. ¹⁵For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father." ¹⁶The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children. ¹⁷Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.

Thrivent Funding update

Every year Thrivent Financial gives congregations a small amount of money to be used within the congregation. There are some guidelines that need to be followed in order to qualify for this money.

1. There must be a free will donation offering at the event given for the church. (Example: Church picnic with a free will basket set out).
2. The event must be entered into the Thrivent Financial system before the event actually happens. Talking to your church's Thrivent Representative ahead of the event will help in getting things entered properly in the system and assure you of some money assistance.
3. Because of the limited funding available, committees should discuss if they want this assistance and contact one of the church's Thrivent reps so that the Thrivent committee can then be sure to sort the money properly among different committees within the congregation.
